A drive up through the amazing landscapes of the Salinas National Reserve will bring you to the Colca Valley, where you will get the chance to see giant Condors circling in the canyon.

Journeying on – and higher still – you will reach the altiplano and the sacred waters of Lake Titicaca. Visit Taquile Island, known for its fine handicrafts, and discover the bizarre floating islands of the Uros people.

Relax on board the Andean Explorer train and take in the scenery en route to the Cusco, the former capital of the ancient Inca Empire. Moving on through the Sacred Valley you will discover more about the Inca civilisation, culminating in a visit to the magical lost hilltop city of Machu Picchu.
